








































































## OASE # 1 OASE # 1 Normal hearing on his right ear No measurable hearing on his left due to trauma Works at LAX and he needs to hear from both ears, otherwise he wouldn't pursue a CROS

### FOLLOW-UP VISIT

- Although he was reluctant to wear the aid and the CROS, he tried it at work and really loved his results
  - He can perform his job duties without having to make special accommodations
     He no longer has difficulty hearing from his left side



- He has also started using it at home
  - He didn't intent to use it at home but does really well
  - His wife is happy that she doesn't always have to sit to his right and repeat everything for



- He Loves the Uni-Dex

  - Uses it exclusively for hands-free phone calls
     Listens to music during his break and "mutes" the hearing aid
- Can plug it into his 2-way radio at work



### CASE#2

• 55 year old shop owner



- Previous binaural hearing aid user
- Sudden hearing loss in her right ear and her hearing aid no longer helps
- $\bullet$  She likes her current aids because she can put them on and forget them





## **AUDIOGRAM** 92% Speech discrimination in her left ear 0% Speech discrimination in her right ear

### **SELECTION**

- Dream 440 Fusion with S receiver in her left ear
  - She has a lot of demands on her better ear
  - Wants to set it and forget it
  - Doesn't care for a VC
  - Currently wearing a RIC product



- She was unconcerned about a VC
- Wanted to "match" her hearing aid ear
- No accessories were purchased







### FOLLOW UP

- She liked the sound quality of the hearing aid She was used to the RIC product
- She loved the simplicity
  - No VC or program buttons She was able to set it and forget it
- She did report that she wished the CROS would automatically turn on
  - We explained that there may be times she would want to turn it off
  - Noisy restaurants
    In the car with windows down

    We showed her to just shut the battery door and push the button
    - Then she never has to push it again if she doesn't need to





### CASE#3

- 72 year old retired police officer
- Patrols on his neighborhood watch
- Has a part time job as a security officer at the local arena
- Long standing hearing loss in his left ear with no hearing in his right as a result of trauma to that ear
- Wears a power BTE in his left ear with a size 13 battery



• Has resisted a CROS because of the battery life and smaller battery size





# AUDIOGRAM Saw his Audiologist for an upgrade to his left hearing aid She had talked to him about CROS before but he didn't want to wear two different styles of hearing aids He decided to try CROS because of his position as a security guard

### **SELECTION**

- Dream 440 Fusion with P receiver for his left ear
  - He has always worn a power BTE
  - He was impressed with the size of the Fusion RIC



- Fusion CROS for his right ear
- He also purchased the M Dex because he wanted hands free phone options, but didn't want to wear anything around his neck.





### FOLLOW-UP

- Initially he only wore the CROS at times because he was used to one hearing aid
- He started wearing it more and noticed the benefit of hearing from all sides
- Loves the size of the Fusion with a power receiver
- Now wearing both full time
- Loves the battery life of both the aid and the CROS
