

How do we inspire patient behavior?

- Your journey begins from the first time you interact with a patient
- Provide information throughout the entire process
 - In case someone is too nervous to ask or still not sure yet
 - Materials available for them to take home
- Make the appointment a conversation
 - Ask questions often
 - Observe body language
- What role does family play in the hearing journey?

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Open Ended Questions

- Get more than a 2-word answer
- Start / continue a conversation
- Uncover the real reason they are in your office

Question starters:

How | Why | What | Tell me | Describe

Tell me what you do outside of the house.

– What's it like in those situations?


