

## Wireless Terminology

## 2.4 GHz Bluetooth Low Energy (BTLE)

- Created for low power data transmission
- Excellent for connectivity between hearing aids and mobile devices (Apple & Android) and for communication with Thrive app
- Not designed for audio streaming

## Starkey Proprietary 2.4 GHz Protocol

 Utilized for connection to Starkey 2.4 GHz accessories (Remote Control, Remote Microphone +, etc.)



## Wireless Terminology

### 2.4 GHz Bluetooth Classic

- Designed to connect phones and other peripherals to each other
- Various protocols (e.g., HFP and A2DP) to stream audio
- Typically, quite power hungry
- Not designed for hearing aid use\*



<sup>\*</sup>Bluetooth Classic is NOT used in Starkey hearing devices



Bluetooth Low Energy allows us to have the best of both worlds – the ability to use a small cell battery and also stream for extended periods of time!



### Low Energy Audio (LEA)

- Apple's proprietary streaming protocol
- Allows direct streaming between Livio Al and Livio devices
- Works in conjunction with Bluetooth Low Energy for pairing and data sharing



## Android Streaming for Hearing Aids (ASHA)

- Proprietary streaming protocol from Android (Google)
- Allows direct streaming between select Android mobile devices\* and Livio AI and Livio
  - Google Pixel 3, Pixel 3 XL, Pixel 3a and Pixel 3a XL phones running Android 10 OS
  - A minimum of Android 10 OS

<sup>\*</sup>A Remote Microphone Plus is still needed for streaming with other Android smart phone models



# Tinnitus Handicap Inventory (THI)

Newman, C. Jacobson, G. Spitzer, J.

Brief, easy to administer and reliable measure of the impact of tinnitus on daily living

Self-report measure consisting of 25 questions

3 subgroups: functional, emotional and catastrophic

Pre-fitting to assess the impact of tinnitus on dail

Post-fitting outcome measure to monitor progres

GRADE	SCORE	DESCRIPTION
1	0-16	Slight: Only heard in quiet environment, very easily masked. No interference with sleep or daily activities.
2	18-36	Mild: Easily masked by environmental sounds and easily forgotten with activities. May occasionally interfere with sleep but not daily activities.
3	38-56	Moderate: May be noticed, even in the presence of background or environmental noise, although daily activities may still be performed.
4	58-76	Severe: Almost always heard, rarely, if ever, masked. Leads to disturbed sleep pattern and can interfere with ability to carry out normal daily activities. Quiet activities affected adversely.
5	78-100	Catastrophic: Always heard, disturbed sleep patterns, difficulty with any activity.
